

Spiral Cellar installation options

The 'KIT' If you feel able to install the Spiral Cellar independently

- You dig the hole for the cellar
- You or your client buy a 'Kit' from Spiral Cellars and you install it yourself
- The Kit has been specifically designed to enable a competent construction team to independently install a Spiral Cellar, even without having any prior cellar knowledge or experience
- However, if this is your first cellar install and you are concerned about the level of difficulty or if you would simply like some on-site help, we suggest you take the Assisted Kit option
- The cellar structure does not come with a warranty. The door motor has a 1-year warranty

The 'ASSISTED KIT' If you would like assisted support from one of our trained installation managers

- You dig the hole for the cellar
- You or your client buy a 'Kit' from Spiral Cellars
- One of our Installation Managers is on site for 3 days to instruct and supervise the installation of the cellar
- You provide 3 construction workers to undertake the cellar installation work
- If you are planning to install additional cellars in the future, the Assisted Kit could be treated as a training exercise.
- The cellar will have a 5-year standard warranty with a 2-year warranty on the door

The 'FIT' If you would like full support from the Spiral Cellars installation team

- You or your client a Spiral Cellar
- You dig the hole for the cellar
- A Spiral Cellars team installs the cellar
- The cellar will have a 5-year standard warranty with a 2-year warranty on the door
- Spiral Cellars manage Building Regulations and provide a completion certificate
- Structural engineer's calculations are included
- You will get full project management support throughout the whole project
